

JEAN-CLAUDE PETIT Composer

Jean-Claude is one of the foremost film composers in France and his scores include the universally acclaimed **Cyrano de Bergerac**, starring Gerard Depardieu, for which Jean-Claude was awarded a BAFTA by the British Academy. He also provided two of most memorable scores in film history for **Jean de Florette** and **Manon des Source**, both appearing in the top 10 of favourite movies around the world. He also produced another much praised soundtrack for the definitive **Les Miserables**, starring John Malkovitch, Gerard Depardieu and Jeanne Moreau.

His English language films include **The Playboys** directed by Gilles Mackinnon; **Lady Chatterley** directed by Ken Russell; **Lumumba**, a contemporary African drama directed by Raoul Peck; **The Return of The Musketeers** directed by Richard Lester; **Nobody's Children**, directed by David Wheatley; and **Foreign Student**, directed by Heva Sereni. He also provided the scores for two major BBC series; **The Scarlet and The Black**, starring Ewan McGegor, directed by Ben Bolt, and **Seaforth**, starring Linus Roache, directed by Peter Smith.

He is one of the few European composers to have enjoyed success in the wider world and in a myriad of styles – from techo to choral and big band to huge orchestral scores. Beaumarchais L'Insolent and Le Hussard Sur le Toit, starring Juliette Binoche and Olivier Martinez, have been both been shown internationally to rave reviews. Recent films include Face, directed by Ming-Liang Tsai; Ganes, directed by JP Siili; Dance With Him, directed by Valérie Guignabodet; Le Passager De L'Eté; Paddy, directed by Gerard Mordillat; Pédale Dure, directed by Gabriel Aghion; Aime Ton Pere, directed by Jacob Berger; Podium, directed by Yann Moix; and Topaze, directed by Gerard Mordillat.

Although probably best known for his work on some of the most successful French period films of the last decade, within France he is also highly respected for the wide range of his skills and talents. Classically trained at The Conservatoire in Paris, he also studied contemporary music at the Ensemble InterContemporain and played piano with Dexter Gordon and Kenny Clarke and others. He has worked with singers Mort Schuman and Joan Baez and written songs for Claude Francois, Juliette Greco among many. His film work ranges from the Armenian inspired **Mayrig** to the despairing, melancholic contemporary sounds of **Le Zebre** and **Fucking Ferdinand**!
