

MIKE SHEPPARD - Composer & Arranger

Mike has had an impressive career over many years as a musician, composer, arranger and record producer. His feature credits include **Two Days Nine Lives** (Stairafilm Motion Pictures); **Letting Go** (BenTen Films); **You Are A Monkey** (Monkey Films); and the shorts **A Lump in the Road** and **Bill of Mortality**, both for Black Mole Prods. He wrote and produced additional music for ITV's **Marple: At Betram's Hote**l; was arranger, MD and music producer on **Marple: The Body in the Library**; and was arranger/music producer on Carnival/ITV's **Poirot**: **The Mystery of the Blue Train**. Other television includes the BBC documentary **Love for Sale**; **The Lady In Red**, **The Birthday Party**, **The Graduate**, **Service With a Smile** all for Faction Films/BBC; and two series of the BBC's **Brum**.

In recent months Mike has been composing extensively for **The Soul Rests Eternal**, his major new classical recording project of evocative music for solo cello and orchestra. This will be recorded and premiered by Caroline Dale and the English Chamber Orchestra next year. Meanwhile in December 2009 Mike's arrangement of the cello piece **'Lullaby'**, for soprano soloist and chorus, was premiered by Natasha Marsh in London at Holy Trinity, Brompton with the Cantate chorus under conductor Michael Kibblewhite.

He earlier produced Artemis' critically acclaimed recording of **Handel's Messiah** and has exec-produced many classical piano recordings with artists such as **Piers Lane**, **Melvyn Tan**, **Joanna MacGregor** and **Noriko Ogawa** for the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music. He has also produced several recordings for Sir Simon Rattle's BCMG.

Mike has written music for some of London's leading advertising agencies for major brand tv/film commercials, including among others, Saatchi & Saatchi for Nestle Cereals, WCRS for RAC Insurance, Grey Advertising for Pringles, and BBH for AEG Lavamat, as well as many station idents for Sky Movies. He also composed an epic orchestral soundtrack for the advertising campaign for Sony's PS3 best-selling game **Heavenly Sword**.

Mike studied classical composition and orchestration at Southampton University, whilst also playing trombone in a number of local big bands and jazz ensembles. He went on to become a leading session musician and arranger and in 1991 he was appointed Managing Editor at the musical publishing giant, Music Sales, working with composers including Michael Nyman, Phillip Glass, Geoffrey Burgon and Craig Armstrong in the preparation of new music for performance and recording.

In 1998 he set up Artemis Media Music, a publishing and production company and he and his composing team produced the soundtracks to many films, a feature animation, a variety of television series and over 1,000 commercial recordings, including tracks for English National Opera, BCMG Records and BBC Worldwide.
